



User notes for completing Attachment One: Contentious material

Under section 14(4) of the Act an application for an interactive film must include particulars of any contentious material in the film and the means by which access to that material may be gained. Contentious material means material that would cause a film to be classified M or higher. See [Guidelines for the Classification of Films and Computer Games](#) for classifiable elements.

Please note that the cases provided on the example attachments form a minimum standard for what must be provided, an applicant may supply more information should they so wish.

If the Board is of the opinion that the information supplied does not adequately reflect the contentious elements and/or how to access them, it may request additional information. This could result in delays to receiving a classification.
