Classification review announced for the film The Nut Job 2: Nutty By Nature

The Classification Review Board has received an application to review the classification of the film *The Nut Job 2: Nutty By Nature*.

The Nut Job 2: Nutty By Nature was classified PG with the consumer advice 'Mild themes and animated violence' by the Classification Board on 18 September 2017.

The Classification Review Board will meet on 20 November 2017 to consider the application. The decision and reasons will later be published on www.classification.gov.au.
